Glenn Fletcher is an Emmy Award–winning writer, family ministry veteran, and the author of *MARK! The Herald Angel* — a Christmas novelette published through his imprint, Abracadaver Press.

Glenn was part of the writing and development team for the five-time Emmy Award–winning animated series *Auto-B-Good*, a distinction that sits at the center of everything he does creatively. That credential isn't a footnote; it's the through-line between a career in storytelling and a life spent inside the church.

For more than 20 years, Glenn has worked in youth ministry, family ministry, children's programming, Christian retail, and the entertainment industry — accumulating a network of hundreds of pastoral relationships across denominations, and an unusually clear sense of what families actually need in December.

MARK! The Herald Angel was built at the intersection of all of it. The story follows a small angelic newspaper reporter named Mark, assigned to cover the birth of Christ for the *Eternal Herald* — Paradise City's journal of record. It is warm, witty, and genuinely tries to give the Nativity story back its weight and wonder. It exists in three formats: a novelette for middle readers and adults, a picture storybook for young children, and a free 12-day Advent devotional for busy families — together forming a complete Advent package suitable for individual families, church adoption, and congregational gifting.

An animated adaptation of the novelette is currently in early development. Glenn describes his brand voice as “fair dinkum” — warm, witty, and more interested in a good story than a good pitch.

Glenn lives in Lawrence, Kansas with his wife Amy and their four children.

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
